### **Only the Paranoid Survive**

Peekskill, NY ... The Hudson Valley Center for Contemporary Art (HVCCA) announces a new exhibition, ***Only the Paranoid Survive***, opening on Sunday September 17, 2006. A reception with the artists will be held from 4:00 – 6:00 pm.

***Only the Paranoid Survive*** focuses on the current “culture of fear” stemming from the continuous bombardment of terror warnings, suspicions and scenarios of impending catastrophes that flourish on nightly news programs. The featured work, curated by Daniel Fuller, centers on the remnants of anxiety and plays with each of our pathological fears. This exhibition will be on view in the mezzanine gallery through January 21, 2007.

Also on view in the main galleries is the critically acclaimed exhibition ***reverence*** through February 26, 2007. ***reverence*** features the work of 33 internationally renowned artists from 13 countries and addresses universal hopes and spiritual aspirations that are beyond specific religious iconography.

The Hudson Valley Center for Contemporary Art is located at 1701 Main Street in Peekskill, New York. The Center is open Saturdays and Sundays, from 11am - 6pm. ### **ABOUT CURATOR DANIEL FULLER:**

Daniel Fuller is the Curator of New Media at the Hudson Valley Center for Contemporary Art and has curated numerous video exhibitions, screenings and lectures. His video programming began at Spark Contemporary Art Space while a graduate student of the Program of Museum Studies at Syracuse University. In October 2005 Fuller was awarded a Curatorial Residency at the Drake in Toronto, which resulted in the exhibition *It's The Same Outside*. Other exhibitions include *Everything I'd Ever Discovered* which traveled from Cirrus Gallery in Los Angeles to Vox Populi in Philadelphia; *Pleasure Principle* (2004) at Light Work - with a curatorial essay published in

Contact Sheet 2005; *Life Most Useful* (2005) at the Joe and Emily Lowe Art Gallery at Syracuse University; and a large group exhibition of gallery artists for Peres Projects in Los Angeles (2004). In February 2005, he was voted Up State NY's 'Most Promising Young Curator' and was invited to judge a traveling exhibition of photography and video work from such schools as Parsons School of Design, Cornell University, Rochester Institute of Technology, Syracuse University, and Ithaca College.
